30th Anniversary Celebration and 30 Reasons to Celebrate!

- 1. Sister Cities International was founded by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1956 as a nonpartisan 501(c)(3) nonprofit which today unites tens of thousands of Citizen diplomats and volunteers in over 300 member communities with over 2,000 partnerships in more than 140 countries.
- 2. It was established to promote peace through mutual respect, understanding, one individual, one community at a time.

 3. Lansing Regional Sister Cities (LRSCC) was incorporated as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit Corporation on August 15, 1994, although
- the first Sister Cities Agreement was signed between the City of Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico and the City of Lansing, Michigan, USA on June 13, 1990 by Mayor Terry McKane and Presidente Municipal Gabriel Covarrubias Ibarra.
- 4. During the Sister Cities International/African Summit of 2023 in Cape Town, South Africa, five Lansing Regional Sister Cities Commissioners were honored during an "Honoring Our Elders' Ceremony at the renowned Gold's Restaurant: President Emerita Barbara Roberts Mason, Dr. Sung Lee, Dr. Willie Davis, Dr. Maxine Hankins Cain, and Commissioner Bill Brewer.
- 5. President Emerita Barbara Roberts Mason and President Maxine Hankins Cain were both named "Sister Cities International Volunteers of the Year" in 2017, and 2019, respectively.
- 6. Our newest Sister City is Merida, Yucatán Mexico, established in May of 2023 during a signing ceremony with Mayor Andy Schor, Dr. Ruben Martinez and President Maxine Hankins Cain.
- 7. President Emerita Barbara Roberts Mason served as President of Lansing Regional Sister Cities for 23 years.
- 8. Mayor Terry McKane, Mayor Tony Benevides, Mayor David Hollister, Mayor Virg Bernero, and Mayor Andy Schor are mayors who have signed Sister City Agreements.
- 9. Two mayors' wives have served on the Lansing Regional Sister Cities Commission: Teri Bernero and Erin Schor.
- 10. Mayor David Hollister signed the original By-laws of the Lansing Regional Sister Cities Commission in 1994.
- 11. Our first office was 124 W. Michigan Avenue, 9th Floor City Hall, Lansing, Michigan 48933-1612.
- 12. On February 7th, 1992, a Sister Cities Agreement between the city of Lansing and the Kuibyshevsky of the city of St. Petersburg was signed, but was disolved years later.
- 13. On August 15, 1994, Articles of Incorporation for the Lansing Regional Sister Cities were filed by Judson Werbelow of Dickerson, Wright, Moon, Van Dusen & Freeman, Counsellors at Law on behalf of the Lansing Regional Sister Cities Commission.
- 14. Judson Werbelow was the first president of the Lansing Regional Sister Cities Commission.
- 15. Honorable David Hollister was the founder of the Lansing Regional Sister Cities Commission.
- 16. The agreement between Asan, Republic of Korea was signed by President Emerita Barbara Roberts Mason and Former Mayor Virg Bernero in Asan.
- 17. South Korea-LRSCC programs have been under the leadership of Commissioners Chris Hodshire, Commissioner Sung Lee and Dr. Won Song.
- 18. Our Sister City of Hohhot scheduled the 2024 Hohhot International Youth Friendly Exchange Camp from July 26 to July 31 and invited 8 students and 2 teachers to attend. If atended, all accommodations and transportation while in Hohhot are borne by the Hohhot Foreign Affairs Office.
- 19. Students from Holt High School, Eastern High School and LRSCC's Youth Activities Committee participated in a Youth Camp in July, 2024 in Asan, South Korea.
- 20. Students from Tanzania and Eastern International Baccalaureate High School hosted four international zoom experiences where students from both schools planned exciting and interactive "Getting to Know You!" activities.
- 21. After years of being dormant, Pianezza, Italy and Lansing are ready to host a student exchange program! How exciting!
- 22. A Declaration of Understanding has been signed and reaffirmed by the Governors of Michigan and the President of the Republic of Ghana.
- 23. Mexico had an active program with the fire department of Guatalajara, Mexico.
- 24. Two commissioners, Barbara Mason and Maxine Hankins Cain, we're enstooled as queen mothers in Ghana. Commissioner Bill Brewer was enstooled as a chief.
- 25. Lillian Kumata led several delegations to Otsu, Japan and also hosted several delegations from Otsu, Japan.
- 26. LRSCC built a health clinic in the traditional village of Nsakye, Akuapem South Municipality and facilitated water, sanitation, health, hygiene, economic development, and education projects in our two sister cities in the Eastern Region.
- 27. Dr. Tai Sung Kim, an LRSCC commissioner and a native of Korea, played a leadership role in the success of our Lansing-Otsu Sister City relationship with LCC.
- 28. The Biwako Kisen Steamship Company under the direction of its president, Mr. Megumi Shigamatsu, built Michigan Cruise boats that sail on Lake Biwa in Otsu.
- 29. Because of growth of our sister city in Ghana, it was divided into two governmental entities; Akuapem South Municipality and Nsawam Adwoagyri.
- 30. The late Lillian Kumata led our Lansing-Otsu programs with excellence for many years.
